Regional Information

Elgin is in Bastrop County, the 6th fastest growing county in Texas. Elgin is conveniently located on Hwy. 290, just 19 miles east of Austin, 30 minutes from Austin Bergstrom International Airport and downtown Austin, within 90 miles of San Antonio, 125 miles of Houston and 180 miles of Dallas.

Education

The Elgin Independent School District is located approximately 22 miles east of Austin and is in the Region 13 Education Service Center area. There are seven campuses: Elgin Elementary North, Elgin Elementary South, Booker T. Washington Elementary School, Neidig Elementary School, Elgin Middle School, Elgin High School and Phoenix High School (Alternative Education). Elgin ISD comprises more than 168 square miles in portions of Bastrop, Lee, and Travis Counties and provides educational facilities and resources to meet the needs of more than 3900 students on seven campuses.

Recreation

Fast becoming an Arts Destination, there is something for everyone in Elgin. From Fine Arts to Fun Arts, Live Music to Local Musicians, Art Galleries to Craft Fairs, artists of all venues have made their home here.

Music and Movies in the Park Series: The City of Elgin Parks and Community Development Department is known for its slogan, Elgin Parks and Recreation, Where the Benefits are Endless! The department along with the Friends of Elgin Parks is providing Live music in Elgin 4-6 times per year with up and coming artists from Austin area. Based on the style of house concerts these start early, and encourages guests to bring their own beverages, snacks, blanket or a lawn chair and be prepared to be entertained. The Music and Movies Series runs from March to July and features family-oriented movies and live bands in downtown Elgin at Veterans' Memorial Park.

Market Days: The first Saturday of each month from February through November, Market Days is held at the beautiful Elgin Memorial Park. The park is located on Main Street just off of Hwy 95 North. Vendors bring everything from flea market to garage sale to craft items to sell at the park.
